Application:

- Read Prov. 4:23. In what area does your heart need to be guarded right now? What are you looking at? What are you desiring? What choices are you making? Are you guarding your heart?
- 2. Are you conscious of your rationalizations? Do you see the destruction that is coming? How long will you live with the agony of your guilt? Let where you are at right now drive you to Jesus.
- 3. True freedom begins with complete confession. What do you need to confess? To whom do you need to confess it? Are you ready to repent of your sin? Are you ready to believe God's Word and receive his gracious forgiveness?
- 4. Are you facing the consequences of your sin alone, with Christ, with a friend? It is possible to face any consequence with the power of Christ at your side. Are you willing? God may be calling you to use your experience in facing the consequences from your sins, to help others face theirs.
